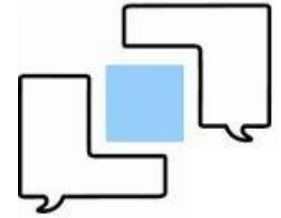


Teaching at Washington English Center

All Volunteers must:

- ✓ be 20 years old or older
- ✓ be a fluent English speaker
- ✓ be willing to make a 10-12 week commitment (one day a week)
- ✓ be willing to attend training before and during each session
- ✓ have regular access to email
- ✓ have the desire to work with adults from different cultural, educational, and economic backgrounds

The volunteer commitment for teaching is **1 day** per week, **2-3 hours** per week.
WEC offers classes year-round – just pick a **term** and a **schedule** that work for you:

mid-September to early December	mid-January to late March	mid-April to late June	mid-July to late August
Weekday	Evening	Weekend	Sunday
Monday – Thursday 10am – 1pm	Monday – Thursday 7pm – 9pm	Saturday & Sunday 2pm – 5pm	9am – 12pm

*Summer classes run on a slightly different schedule
