- ✓ be 20 years old or older
- ✓ be a fluent English speaker
- ✓ be willing to make a 10-12 week commitment (one day a week)
- ✓ be willing to attend training before and during each session
- √ have regular access to email
- √ have the desire to work with adults from different cultural, educational, and economic backgrounds

The volunteer commitment for teaching is 1 day per week, 2-3 hours per week. **WEC** offers classes year-round – just pick a **term** and a **schedule** that work for you:
